Student cannot move ahead without completing the current stage in given time line. **Only volunteer marked things are optional and they can skip if they want to but they will miss the learning part of that stage.**

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<p>LEAAD promotes learning through live actions. Under the program, participants are encouraged and mentored to execute community development project called as “ACTION PROJECT”.</p> <p>In Action Projects, students choose any topic of their interest. It can be a business model, scientific model or related to social problems. 4	<b>Stage 4:</b> Action project Selection & Leadership Interaction	Leadership Interaction* <i>(scrutinization for the next stage)</i>	<p>Leadership Interaction is the first stage of scrutinization and has two parts:</p> <p><b>A) Selection of Topic:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students have to select one topic as per the Action Project Themes sent to them and plan what they will (want to) do in their Action Project.</li> <li>Participants will get 2-3 days to decide the theme.</li> </ol> <p><b>Note:</b> <i>required guideline and information will be provided by LEAAD team</i></p> <p><b>B) About interaction:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The interaction will be done with the panel of jury through “Skype call” or any format of video call.</li> <li>Participants will be informed well in advance regarding their time slot and date for the interaction.</li> <li>Each participant gets 15 minutes to interact with our panel of jury members.</li> </ol> <p><b>The interaction topics will be:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Leadership experience at school / family / community. (They can add more data and other updates if they have)</li> <li>✓ The result will be announced on the same day.</li> </ul> <p><b>Jury will score based on:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Performance in field and presentation</li> <li>2. Outcome of project</li> <li>3.
